

Jorge Balduzzi joined Michelle Bachelet, President of Chile, on official visit to China and South Korea

The President of Chile, Michelle Bachelet, invited Mr. Jorge Balduzzi to join her in the official presidential tour to China and South Korea on November of 2009. The Balduzzi Winery continues to export its Premium wine successfully to both Asian countries. Mr. Balduzzi attended meetings and feasts with the highest authorities of China, South Korea and Chile.

The first destination of the official journey consisted on China. Shanghai's Mayor, Tang Dengjie, and other important political and business representatives welcomed the Chilean delegation and gathered for a meeting. Afterwards, the Mayor offered a ceremonial dinner at the Hong Qiao State Guest Hotel. The delegation also visited the Chilean Hall at the Expo Shanghai 2010 and the Shanghai Jiao Tong University. Mr. Balduzzi also met the executives of Jointek, the firm which imports Balduzzi's wine into China.

The next stop was South Korea. The official delegation was received by President Lee Myung-bak at the Palace Cheong Wa Dae, also known as the Blue House. After a meeting, the President invited the guests for a banquet and a show of Korean Opera. The delegation assisted to the Confederacy of Industry, Commerce and Finance, as well as the University EHWA. In Seoul, capital of South Korea, Mr. Balduzzi joined the high representatives of Lotte, importers of Balduzzi wine, for a meeting.
